



2017 GAYLE HANSHAW ALL-CONFERENCE SHOOT RULES

1. Only shooters with an ECTC current season average (must participate in 5 or more regular season shoots) who are eligible for All-Conference awards are eligible to shoot during this event.
2. Coaches are required to pre-register ELIGIBLE shooters that will be participating in this shoot during the week prior to the shoot as follows:
 - a. The Conference will post a list of eligible shooters by team on the ECTC website on the next day following the last day of the Conference Shoots. The Conference Statistician, Pam Scholz will accept all registrations from the coaches which are due on the Tuesday prior to the shoot by 10:00 PM. Late registrations will not be accepted. Registration via e-mail to **scholz.pam@gmail.com** is preferred. Squad assignments will be posted on the ECTC website by Thursday during the week prior to the All-Conference Shoot.
 - b. A shooter will not be allowed to re-squad if they miss their squad. Entry fees will not be refunded for missed squads or scratches after squad assignments are published.
3. The 2017 All-Conference Shoot will be held on April 29, 2017 with Seniors at Lincoln Trap & Skeet and Juniors at Lincoln Izaak Walton. Both locations will begin at 8:00 a.m. The All-Conference Awards Ceremony will take place at each location once shooting is concluded.
4. All eligible shooters will be classified based on their ECTC Season Average with an equally divided number of shooters in each class:
 - a. JUNIOR DIVISION(grades 6-8) – 12 Classes
 - i. A1, A2, A3,
 - ii. B1, B2, B3,
 - iii. C1, C2, C3,
 - iv. D1, D2, and D3
 - b. SENIOR DIVISION (grades 9-12) – 20 Classes
 - i. AA1, AA2, AA3, AA4
 - ii. A1, A2, A3, A4
 - iii. B1, B2, B3, B4
 - iv. C1, C2, C3, C4
 - v. D1, D2, D3, and D4
5. Each Division will consist of one (1) event each:
 - a. JUNIOR DIVISION (grades 6-8) – 50 sixteen yardage targets
 - b. SENIOR DIVISION (grades 9-12) – 50 handicap yardage targets – yardage determined by each individual's 16 yard season average and class will be determined by their handicap season average.
6. The cost of the 2016 All-Conference Shoot shall be \$11.00 for Juniors and \$11.00 for Seniors.

7. All awards for this shoot will be Individual awards which will be provided for 1st, 2nd and 3rd Place in each of the classes. Awards for the All-Conference Shoot will be provided by the Eastern Cornhusker Trapshooting Conference.
8. In the event of ties, shoot-offs will determine placement in each of the classes.
9. Scoreboards must be kept in plain sight of the shooter and coaches.
10. Cash Awards may not be made directly to shooters.
11. Approved eye and ear protection are required to be worn by all shooters while shooting at Conference shoots. Any shooter observed not wearing eye and/or ear protection will be informed to get eye and/or ear protection or be removed from competition until eye and/or ear protection is secured.
12. The use of drugs, alcohol and/or tobacco products by students at Conference shoots is prohibited.
13. The use of toe tabs for resting of muzzles is not permitted by the Eastern Cornhusker Trapshooting Conference during sanctioned competitions. Participants shall not rest muzzles on the top of their foot or any other part of their body at anytime.
