



LUKE LUESCHEN MEMORIAL CONFERENCE BUILDER AWARD

The **Luke Lueschen Memorial Conference Builder Award** is named in honor of the late Luke Lueschen, a co-founder of the Eastern Cornhusker Trapshooting Conference and a long time Coach of the Fremont High School Trapshooting team. This award is for those individuals who have performed extraordinarily commendable individual acts of service for the betterment of the **Eastern Cornhusker Trapshooting Conference (ECTC)**. These contributions shall be of less significance when compared to the **Outstanding Contributions Award (OCA)**. Recipients shall receive the **Luke Lueschen Memorial Conference Builder Award**.

The **Luke Lueschen Memorial Conference Builder Award** will be a 7 inch by 14 inch solid walnut plaque in the shape of the State of Nebraska laser engraved with the ***name of the Conference, name of the recipient and year of award.***

Luke Lueschen Memorial Conference Builder Award nominations must be made in writing detailing the contribution(s) for which the nominee is nominated. Nominations will be forwarded to the Awards Committee, which will screen and verify the accuracy of the written nominations, and, prior to the Annual Conference Board of Directors Meeting, present to the Board of Directors, for final consideration and approval at the Annual Meeting.
